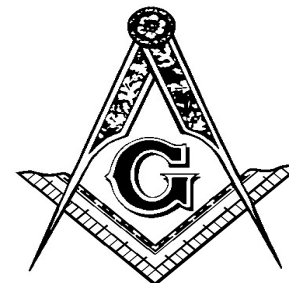

Greetings Upon the Angle of the Square,

As we continue our journey from the West to the East in search of 'more light' in Masonry our School of Instructions will also move from the EA to the FC Degree. The FC Degree emphasizes the individual's dignity and worth; representing man as an instrument of the Supreme Architect of the Universe and a workman whose duty is to invent, create, and achieve. Thus, the Degree reinforces one of our key enablers in life by expressing our own genius and individuality. The Degree of FC symbolizes man in the prime years of his life, who accepts the responsibility of life. Additionally, he accepts the responsibility for his own destiny and that of the Nation State (GL-217, 2008). In today's political, humanitarian, and financial environments this responsibility is at the forefront of our duties.

Some of us may not realize the fact that the father of Masonic Rituals was Williams Preston (1742-1818), who conceived Masonry as the vehicle by which man may become well educated in the liberal arts and sciences. 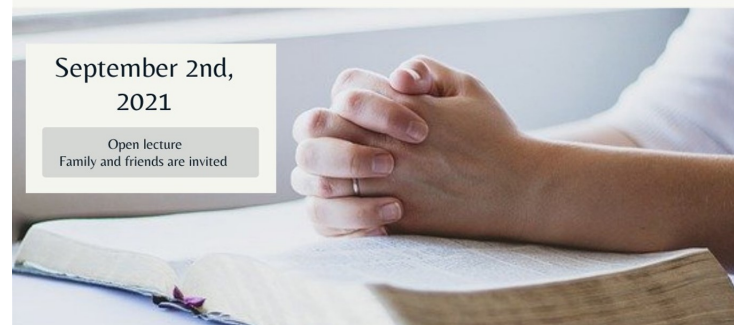

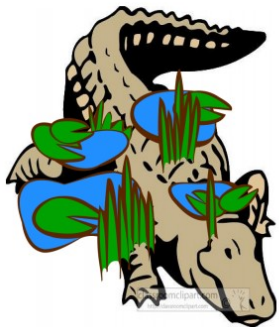
