



RH:. Matt Goldstein, District 26th Instructor The Sublime Degree of Master Mason is often thought of as the ultimate degree of Freemasonry.

However, many Masonic scholars agree that the narrative of the Craft, as illustrated in the three degrees, is not the whole story.

In the York Rite, A Master Mason may become a member of three bodies. Actually a group of separate Rites joined in order.



These include:
Chapter of Royal Arch Masons;
Council of Royal and Select Masters;
Commandery of Knights Templar.

The Degrees of York Rite Masonry complete the story and provide answers to many questions that the newly-raised Master Mason may have. By joining the York Rite, a Master Mason may proceed to supplement and expand upon the degrees of the Blue Lodge.

THE ROYAL ARCH DEGREES fill in the spaces of the Craft (Blue Lodge) Degrees, showing how a Mason asks for his wages and rediscovering the Lost Word. The Royal Arch Degree is percieved as more august, sublime and important than those which have preceded it and is the very summit of perfection in Ancient Masonry. With the discoveries of the missing sacred treasure at the rebuilding of the Temple of Solomon, that which was lost in the Master Mason Degree is restored to the Craft in a vivid portrayal of epic events.

THE CRYPTIC DEGREES are considered some of the most beautiful in Freemasonry and tell the story before and after the Word was lost. Fidelity is rewarded and the candidate is taught to guard the secrets of the degree with sleepless vigilance. See our three Grand Masters in action.

THE CHIVALRIC ORDERS pertain to the obligations of knighthood, joining the Order of Malta, the illustrious order of the Red Cross and the Order of the Temple (Knights Templar). The Order of the Temple is the most impactful in the series. During the ceremonies the candidate represents a knight of the era that succeeded the Crusades and vowed to visit the Holy Sepulcher. The ritual teaches beautiful lessons on the death and ascension of our Savior and the candidate is at last received into full fellowship in the most solemn manner.


